
Printable paper collars for cats

If you've found a cat and you're unsure as to whether they have an owner, use our handy paper collars. These are good to attach to a cat to contact a possible owner, if there is one.

Only use these collars if the cat is friendly and happy to be handled by you. If they aren't, or they run away then leave them be.

Instructions:

1. Print out this template.
2. Write your contact telephone number in the space provided and cut out one collar.
3. To prevent tearing the tape near the cat, ensure it's prepared beforehand.
Just use a small piece of tape so if they get trapped the collar tears off.
4. Ensure the fitted collar allows for two fingers to be placed between the collar and the cat's neck.
5. If you get no response from the owner, call your local Cats Protection branch or centre, or contact our Information Helpline on 03000 12 12 12.
